Małgorzata Krasnodębska-Tomkiel had been Vice-President of the OCCP since 21 June 2007, responsible for the operations of the Department of Competition Protection, Department of Legal Affairs and European Jurisprudence and Department of Market Surveillance. She has been working for the Office of Competition and Consumer Protection since 1998.

Dr Krasnodębska-Tomkiel has been a lecturer of Community and antimonopoly law at Warsaw University, Warsaw School of Economics, National School of Public Administration and Higher School of Public Administration in Ostrołęka.

Małgorzata Krasnodębska-Tomkiel is the author of a number of publications in the scope of Polish and Community competition protection law, including academic works, glosses to the Polish Supreme Court 's decisions and press articles.
