Ms. Purcell White joined the Antitrust Division of the U.S. Department of Justice in 1991. She is a supervisor in the Foreign Commerce Section – a section that assists the Assistant Attorney General, Deputy Assistant Attorney General, and other Antitrust Division sections in formulating and implementing international antitrust enforcement and competition policy. As Assistant Chief, she has been actively involved in the International Competition Network (ICN) since its inception and she manages the Division’s technical assistance program, among other duties. Prior to her international work, Ms. Purcell White supervised merger investigations and litigation, and served as a Special Assistant in the Office of Operations. She also worked on cartel, merger, and civil non-merger matters as a trial attorney in the Division’s Telecommunications Task Force, Merger Task Force, and Cleveland Field Office. In 1998, in connection with the Division’s technical assistance program, Ms. Purcell White served as a resident advisor to the Comision Nacional De Defensa De La Competencia in Buenos Aires, Argentina, where she conducted weekly seminars on antitrust law and consulted on investigative and policy matters.
