Gianluca Sepe joined the Italian Competition Authority in 1998, after completing his studies in Rome, London and Florence. He has been working in the Directorate for Research and International Affairs since June 2006.

While in his current position, Gianluca co-chaired the ECA working group on sanctions and was actively involved in several ECN and ICN working groups. He led the drafting of the Italian leniency programme, adopted in 2007. Gianluca was also in charge of projects of international co-operation and technical assistance between the Italian authority and other competition agencies.

His earlier professional experience within the Italian Competition Authority includes case handling in the investigative departments, as well as legal counselling in the agency's Legal Service. Gianluca was also seconded as a national expert to the European Commission's Directorate General for Consumer Protection for 18 months.
