

BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Shuichi Sugahisa

Mr. Shuichi SUGAHISA is Director of the International Affairs Division of the Japan Fair Trade Commission (JFTC). He is responsible for international affairs regarding competition matters, such as matters related to the International Competition Network (ICN) and Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD). Prior to the appointment to his current position in June 2007, he was Director of the Coordination Division which is in charge of introduction of competition into the areas exempted from the Antimonopoly Act and the regulated industries. From April 2004 to June 2006, he was in charge of planning and implementation of the Premiums and Representations Act as Director of Consumer-related Trade Division. He joined the JFTC in 1983.

Mr. Sugahisa has written on antitrust policy of Japan, for example, ‘*Wettbewerbspolitik in Japan (competition policy in Japan)*’ (*Zeitschrift fuer Betriebswirtschaft (ZfB)* 64.Jg. (1994) H2, 153-166), ‘*Amendment of the Anti-Monopoly Act of Japan*’ (*Zeitschrift fuer Japanisches Recht (ZJapanR) No.20 (2005)*) and in Japanese ‘*Dokusenkinshi Seisaku (anti-monopoly policy)*’ (Ch.12 of “*Gendai Sangyou-Soshiki-Ron (modern industrial organization)*”, co-authored with Prof. Masu UEKUSA, Prof. Hideki IDE, Prof. Koji TAKENAKA and Associate Prof. Akiko HORIE, published by NTT Publishing Co., Ltd., 2002).
